Marin Vuković is an Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing, University of Zagreb, Croatia (UNIZG-FER). He received his diploma degree in electrical engineering with a major in telecommunications and informatics from the UNIZG-FER in April 2006. He has been employed at the Department of Telecommunications at UNIZG-FER since October 2006 in the position of Research Associate. He started his PhD studies in October 2006 at the UNIZG-FER, which he successfully finished in June 2011 by defending his dissertation titled "Adaptive location information management for value-added telecommunication services ". He actively participated in panels, round tables and held invited lectures with the goal of popularization of science and profession. He is a co-author of the patent at the Croatian Institute for Intellectual Property.
